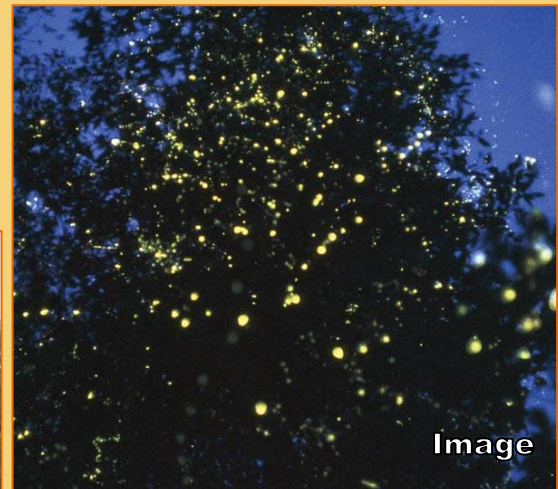

Located south of Kota Kinabalu with approximately 1.5 hours drive, Klias wetland is known to be mangrove forest reserve inhabited by the endemic Proboscis Monkeys. Aside from the Proboscis monkeys, you may also find other wildlife species such as Long Tail Macaque monkeys, big water lizards, silver Monkeys, variety of birds, sometimes crocodiles and more. When the night folds you will be amazed by the volume of fireflies surrounding the wetland which forms living Christmas trees around the area.

In this tour you are able to watch the proboscis monkeys in their natural habitat as well as the fireflies at night. Start with 1.5 hours drive from Kota Kinabalu to the Klias jetty where you are able to try on the local pastries upon arrival. Proceed to the first river cruise the in search of the Proboscis monkeys and other wildlife. You will also be amazed to see one of the best sunset in world. Dinner will be served on the jetty afterwards before heading on the second river cruise to search for the night stars of the wetland reserve.

Depart from Jetty after tour end and expect to reach back hotel around 2100-2200hrs.

Nabalu Village-this village is located 900m height. If whether condition is good, you can see the breathtaking Kinabalu mountain from the observation tower. You can experience local market as well.

Kinabalu Park – the first World Heritage site in Malaysia covers 754 square kilometers of flora & fauna haven. In this park you are able to find a variety of plants as well as birds, insects, amphibians, & reptiles.the botanic garden is located in the national park 1500m height.

Poring Hot Spring is another attraction not to be missed by the visitors who come to Kota Kinabalu. Situated 40 kilometers (25 miles) slightly northeast from the Parks HQ, Poring is located in the lowlands—a contrast to the Parks HQ. Soak away your stress with the running hot sulphuric water said to have healing effects. Besides the hot spring, you may also climb the canopy walkway which is 41 meters above ground level to observe the wildlife without disturbing them.

An interesting escape that will only take you 1 hour from the city of Kota Kinabalu to a breathtaking backdrop of Mount Kinabalu and placing you at the second most beautiful village in Malaysia. Located somewhere on the northwestern part of Sabah, Kiulu River graded as Class I - II river is safe enough for children and gentle enough for the elderly.

Trip begins with a safety briefing session conducted by our professional raft guide that will demonstrates rafting techniques and proper handling of rafting equipment before rafting commences. Excursion covers up to 15km, making it the longest white water rafting trip in Borneo. The journey will take about 1.5- 2 hours of rafting before reaching the ending point where delicious barbecue lunch prepared just by the riverbank.
